Skills shortage statistics

Construction Skills Network (CSN) stats regarding skills shortage

- 22,800 workers are needed in London by 2027
- Construction sector qualification certificates issued for Level 2+ in the UK was higher in 2022 compared to 2020, but still below 2019 and 2021 figures.
- Five regions are projected to have annual average growth rates above the UK's 1.5% from 2023 to 2027, these are the East of England, Greater London, East Midlands, the Southeast, and Yorkshire & the Humber.

The aim from CSN is to recruit new staff and fill vacancies in response to the Skills Gap. They hope to do this through a number of avenues:

- Engage skilled workers who are working elsewhere within the industry
- Attracting skilled workers who have left the industry




Filling the gap in the construction labour market

Recruiting and training new entrants as well as reskilling existing workers has been the main aims of Construction Helpline since inception.

According to the CITB, the construction workforce needs to rise to an estimated 2.78 million workers by 2026. However, current projections suggest it will be 266,000 workers short, with 50,000 workers needed per year. The most critical skills shortages are within the carpentry, joinery and construction managers. With understaffing also occurring in electrical and civil engineering. CITB Chief Executive added that 45,000 overseas workers had left the UK and not returned and that many skilled workers, especially those in their 50s, had changed their livelihood due to the pandemic lockdowns.


